Let us read with our eyes and listen with our souls and let our lives be transformed to what God intends them to be.

(Invocation by Charles Fillmore) I AM now in the presence of pure Being, and immersed in the Holy Spirit of Life, Love, and Wisdom.

I acknowledge Thy presence and Thy power, O blessed Spirit; in Thy divine wisdom, now erase my mortal limitations and from Thy pure substance of Love, bring into manifestation my world, according to Thy perfect law.
